The in-roof option sets the panels flush with the roof tiles (like a skylight). The Double Glazed option boosts winter performance by around 10-15%.

All prices include VAT at 5%. Government grants of £400 are available towards our installations, please ask us for details.

## What is included:

- Solar panels, installed and fixed to roof;
- New, double-insulated, vented hot water cylinder, fitted and connected to existing boiler;
- New 3kW immersion heater in cylinder;
- Solar circuit from cylinder through loft to roof above, including pump, valves and expansion vessel;
- Sensors and electronic controls;
- Testing and commissioning;
- Five-year guarantee;
- Quick, professional, accredited installations;
- Experienced assistance with planning applications;
- Expert advice on all aspects of solar energy;
- Free technical site survey.

## What is not included:

(but we can do if needed at modest extra cost)

- Mains pressure or custom-made cylinders can be fitted from £ 300 extra.
- Repairs or upgrades to boiler circuit. Standard upgrade to a twin-valve circuit £ 490.
- Integration to combi boilers, using a Grants Combi-Sol system £560.
- Alterations to airing cupboard or boxing-in of solar pipework (e.g. in converted lofts).
- Any additional electrical work required.
- Travel over 40 miles from our base.
- Scaffolding (see note below): £ 200 – £ 600.

## Which system is right for you?

The size of the system will depend on your house and circumstances, but typically:

- 1 person: 1 Premium panel
- 2-3 people: 2 Compact panels or 18-tube array
- 2-4 people: 2 Premium panels or 24-tube array

### Note on scaffolding:

Where we cannot use our scaffolding tower to put the panel on the roof, (e.g. due to a porch or bay-fronted window below the roof), to ensure the safety of our staff and to comply with Health & Safety legislation, full scaffolding to eaves is needed to give access to that part of the roof. We can arrange this for you – and it can be an excellent opportunity for you to do other jobs, like clean gutters, replace broken slates and prune creepers!
